Attention All Parents READ This Message

YOU are not permitted to stop, park, drop-off or pick-up your child in the street or cul-de-sac. You must pull into the parking lot, loop around and then drop your child where they can then cross at the cross walk. If you are worried about your child crossing the street then take a few extra minutes, park your car and then walk your child to practice.

We had a young football player last week who was clipped by a mirror of a passing truck because his parent dropped him off in the street and the opposing traffic did not see him as he darted into the street from behind the vehicle.

We are doing this for the safety of your child and the other children in our program. We have approximately 285 children arriving for practice on any given night so PLEASE follow the rules. The YMCA has plenty of parking. If you are worried about getting a good spot then arrive early!



Each year the Jaguar's program makes an effort to take on a community service project and give back to the community—the same community that helps to support our program.

- Potato chips, cookies and other snacks (should be non-perishable and things that won't melt)
- Magazines, books, DVD's and CD's
- Sun block or Chapstick
- Individual drink mixes to add to their water (Crystal light, Lemonade)
- Protein bars
- Canned items such as tuna, chicken, fruit cocktail (pop-top preferred)
