6-8 FOOTBALL

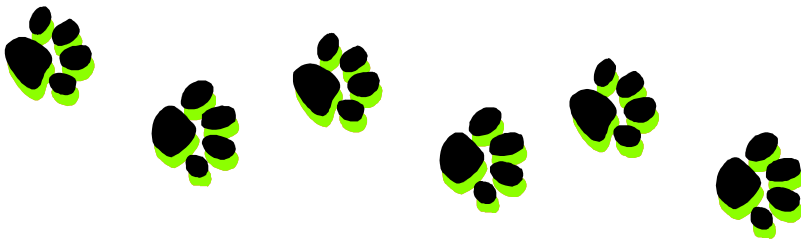
