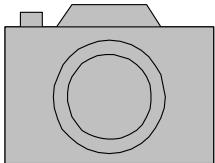
A Message from Kellee Trice:

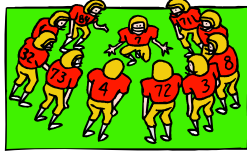
Parking
